

“The Bruce” June 8th and 9th, 2024

Three player teams will compete in a scramble format over 36 holes to determine a gross and net champion in two divisions. If a player does not have a current USGA index, that player will be assigned a 0 index. Maximum handicap differential will be 12 strokes; maximum individual handicap will be 30.

Teams will be comprised of three players with no gender restrictions. Three men, three women or a mixture can form a team.

Appropriate tee for each individual will be determined by the grid below.

Two numerically even divisions will be formed by team handicap. Team handicap will be calculated by using the USGA recommended 30%/20%/10% method. Ties will be settled via scorecard runoff using the USGA modified method. The two divisions will be divided based upon the team handicap. The number of paid teams will be determined by the number of entries within each division.

If there are any interested gamblers, on Sunday, we will have an optional Honey Pot game. The buy-in will be \$100 per team. Number of teams paid will be dependent upon number of entries. Just a little something to keep your interest if you happen to go high the first day!
