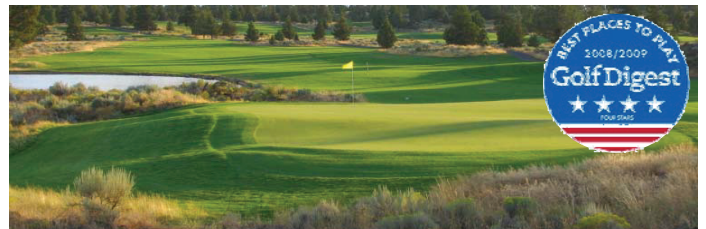

The Resident-Partial Year membership at Juniper Golf Course is an all-inclusive membership that allows all eligible family members the opportunity to play unlimited golf whenever the golf course is available for open play during the months of the year they chose for their partial-year membership. Eligible family members include the member, spouse, minor children and children under 23 that are still attending school.

Dues: Varies depending on months
Chosen to play. (See chart)

Power Cart: Varies depending on months
(Optional Choice) Chosen to play (See chart)



Being on the power cart program, entitles any eligible family member a seat in a cart for the months of the year they chose their membership to include. Member rates in 2018 are \$17 per rider for 18 holes, \$11 per rider for 9 holes. Guests and other riders must pay a rider fee.

Range Balls: Discounted and annual options available

All range ball usage is at the option and expense of members and their guests. An annual option of \$150 per member per year or \$250 per family per year is available. The member rate is currently \$2.50 per 30 ball drop.

Discounts: Guest Green Fees for their chosen months

When guests play with you, and they live over 100 miles from Redmond, they are given a 50% discount off of the applicable green fee rate.

Pro Shop Merchandise

All members are entitled to a member discount on purchases from the pro shop. Currently, the discount provides 15% off on purchases from \$20-\$199. Purchases in excess of \$200 will receive a 20% discount. These discounts are off regular prices. Merchandise discount is applicable for the entire year.

Reciprocal Play Privileges

Juniper Golf Course currently belongs to a group of courses called Oregon Trail Sister Clubs. As member clubs, an agreement is in place that allows members from sister clubs to play for a cart fee, no green fee is charged. Tee times **must** be arranged through the home course professional staff. (The fees for this program are currently being negotiated. They may change slightly.)

Food Minimum

Each partial year member is required to meet the club food minimum. The food minimum is \$50 per quarter with no food minimum in the first quarter of the year. If you purchase \$35 in food throughout the quarter, you would receive a food minimum charge of \$15 on your next billing. If you purchase food in excess of \$50, you would see no food minimum charge (just the charges for the food you purchased.).

This chart will provide the information needed to help you determine the various options you have in choosing your partial year membership. To be a partial year member, you must choose the months of the year you wish to be a member. You are required to choose a minimum of 6 months.

To be a partial year member, you must choose a minimum of 6 months of the calendar year. It is your choice as to what months you choose. Add up the value of the months you choose and that is the amount of your annual dues. Payment is due at time of sign up. If you wish to add the cart option, then add \$75 per month for a family or \$60 per month for a single times the number of months you chose. This is added to the total and paid in the annual payment.

Examples:	Family: May-October(6 mo.)= \$1,910	w/cart	\$2,330
	Single: May-October(6 mo.)= \$1,710	w/cart	\$2,040
	Family: April-November(8 mo.) = \$2,280	w/cart	\$2,840
	Single: April-November(8 mo.)=\$2,080	w/cart	\$2,520
	Annual Family(12 mo.)=\$ 2,530	w/cart	\$3,300
	Annual Single(12 mo.)=\$ 2,090	w/cart	\$2,695

Partial Year Members are required to fulfill the quarterly food minimum (see page one). There is no food minimum for the first quarter of the year (Jan-Feb-Mar) so there will be no delaying food minimums.
